How to Lubricate Sticky Drawers, Windows, and Doors

Wooden drawers have a tendency to stick when the humidity changes inside. Clean the drawer slides first. Wipe them down with a damp cloth, and try to remove all dust. Remove any built up residues with a putty knife.

Apply your choice of SLIPIT lubricant to the drawers. Retreat as needed. Unfinished wood may need more frequent applications. Also, watch for a wax build-up as the oil soaks into the wood, depending on tightness of grain.

Sticky windows are treated the same way as drawers. Apply SLIPIT on sliding or contact points. Apply to cranks, and pivot points.

Doors may be lubricated at points of contact with the frame, hinges, handles, and closing mechanisms.

SLIPIT is food grade safe.
